Who should attend?

- *Kenshi 2-dan to 7-dan*: To **improve your** referee skills & kendo techniques
- *Team members/coaches*: To understand valid points and hansoku at US Championships and other tournaments
- *Kenshi 2 dan and 3 dan*: To fulfill your referee knowledge requirements for promotion
- *Kenshi 4 dan and above*: To fulfill your skill requirements for promotion
- *Dojo sensei*: To improve your instruction of Kendo and skills at your dojo
- **Any kenshi with desire to learn is a plus**
- Also, those considering for US Championship referee selection
- 1 Dan may attend as shiai-sha participants (please register also)

What each person should bring:

- **Kendo-gi and dogu** (participants are expected to actively participate as shiai-sha as well)
- **Mejirushi** (red/white ribbons) for self
- **Shimpan-ki** (referee flags) for self
- **FIK Referee Rules and Regulations Handbook** (2006 version), *especially 4 dan and above*
 - o **mandatory** (read prior to attending seminar)
 - o **optional** AJKF Shinpan Tebiki -(Referee Handbook) Courtesy of Idaho Kendo Dojo

- Sunday:
 - o A.M.: Instructional
 - Instructions on rules/regulations and new information on hansoku
 - 2 and 3 Dan: Basic instruction
 - 4 Dan and above: Advance instruction
 - *Note: Be familiar with "basic conduct/movement/flag positioning/judgment calls," as we will assume that 3-dan and above are knowledgeable of these items. This will expedite the morning session.*
 - o Lunch: Optional bento (see attached application)
 - o P.M.: Practical
 - Training exercises with multiple courts with immediate feedback from instructors
 - Godo-keiko with all participants as time permits
